ADDENDUM NO. 01

This Addendum is issued to amend/revise certain provisions of the Bid Documents for the above-captioned procurement. Said amendments are as follows:

- I. Section III- Bid Data Sheet has been revised to read as follows:
 - ITB Clause 5.3
 - For this purpose, similar contract shall refer to supply, installation and/or repair of **drive motors coupled centrifugal pumps**.
The Bidder must have completed within the last five (5) years a single contract that is similar to this requirement, the amount of which shall be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.
 - ITB Clause 20.2- Post qualification Requirements
 - Item "d"- Brochures of the **pump, drive motor and centrifugal system** being offered;
- II. Section V- Schedule has been revised to read as follows:
 - GCC Clause 5
 - One (1) year warranty for materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor after final completion and acceptance by PICC or its representative. This means that a part or some parts, which will give-way within the warranty period, shall be repaired/replaced by the Contractor at no extra cost to

the owner/PICC. The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money or **special bank guarantee** in the amount equivalent to at least **five percent (5%)** of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period.

III. Section VIII-Checklist of Technical and Financial Documents has been changed to read as:

The obligation for the warranty shall be covered by, at the Contractor's option, either retention money or <i>special bank guarantee</i> in an amount equivalent to at least <i>five percent (5%)</i> of the total contract price. The said amount shall only be release after the lapse of the warranty period.</p>
6	<p>The period for correction of defects is seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of notice from PICC project-in-charge.</p>

- (f) Original duly signed Omnibus Sworn Statement (OSS) **and** if applicable, Original Notarized Secretary's Certificate in case of a corporation, partnership, or cooperative; or Original Special Power of Attorney of all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder (**Annex "D"**).
