### **Invitation to Bid for the Procurement of additional safety personal protective equipment (PPE), individual emergency kit and safety tool for PICC employees**

1. The *Philippine International Convention Center (PICC)*, through the *Approved Budget for CY 2025*, intends to apply the sum of **EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY NINE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS ONLY (Php 869,500.00)**, VAT Inclusive, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **PROCUREMENT OF ADDITIONAL SAFETY PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE), INDIVIDUAL EMERGENCY KIT AND SAFETY TOOL FOR PICC EMPLOYEES. (PICC APP 2025-MC-01)**. Bids received in excess of the sub-ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The *PICC* now invites bids for the above Procurement Project. Delivery of the Goods is required within **Thirty (30) calendar days**. Bidders should have completed, within three (3) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the *PICC-BAC* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by prospective bidders on **April 05, 2025** from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of *Nine Hundred Pesos (Php900.00)*. A bidder shall present its proof of payment for the fee by *furnishing the PICC-BAC a copy of the Official Receipt*.
6. The *PICC-BAC* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **April 14, 2025 at 11:00 a.m.**, at *Function Room B, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Secretariat Building, PICC* and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting *via Zoom*, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before **April 28, 2025 at 10:30 a.m.** Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
9. Bid opening shall be on **April 28, 2025, at 11:00 a.m.** at the given address below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend the activity.

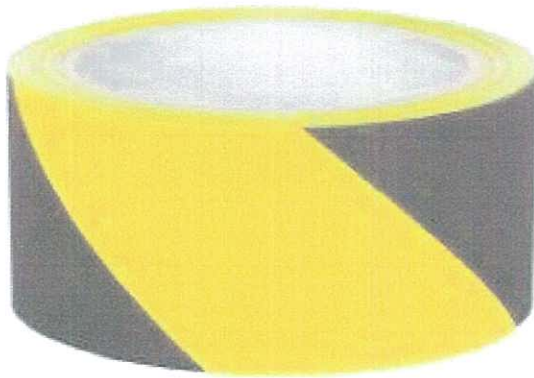
