ADDENDUM NO. 01

This Addendum is issued to amend/revise certain provisions of the Bid Documents for the above-captioned procurement. Said amendments are as follows:

- I. Section I- Invitation to Bid has been revised to read as:
 - 2. The *PICC* now invites bids for the abovementioned requirement. Bidders should have completed, within **ten** (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the abovementioned requirement. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- II. Section III- Bid Data Sheet has been revised to read as:
 - ITB Clause 5
 - 5. Must be engaged in business of supply, installation and repair maintenance of escalators or elevators with PCAB license, Category D and Size and Range Small B with SP-ES specialty.
 - ITB Clause 5.3
 - For this purpose, a similar contract shall refer to provision/supply, installation and service contractor of elevators or escalators and escalators.

The Bidder must have completed, within the last ten (10) years, one (1) contract similar to the project, valued at least 50% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), or by having two similar completed contracts with an aggregate value of at least 50% of the ABC, with the largest of the two being at least 25% of the ABC.

Therefore, it shall be posted only for the final billing and payment in lieu of five percent (5%) money for the whole project.

Invitation to Bid for the Supply and Installation of Two (2) Units Passenger Elevators and One (1) Unit Freight Elevator as Replacement of the Old/Existing Units Serving the Delegation and Secretariat Building

- 1. The Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), through the Approved Budget for CY 2025, intends to apply the sum of THIRTY-FOUR MILLION TWELVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-SIX PESOS (\$\mathbb{P}\$34,012,476.00), VAT Inclusive, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for Supply and Installation of Two (2) Units Passenger Elevators and One (1) Unit Freight Elevator as Replacement of the Old/Existing Units Serving the Delegation and Secretariat Building (PICC APP2025-MC-51). Bids received in excess of ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The *PICC* now invites bids for the abovementioned requirement. Bidders should have completed, within **ten** (10) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the abovementioned requirement. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the *PICC-BAC* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by prospective bidders starting April 9, 2025 from the given address and website(s) below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P21,250.00). A bidder shall present its proof of payment for the fee by furnishing the PICC-BAC a copy of the Official Receipt.

The *PICC-BAC* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **April 22, 2025** at **1:30 p.m.** at Function Room B (FR-B), 2nd Floor Secretariat Building, PICC and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Zoom/Google Meet, which shall be open to prospective bidders (see interim guidelines for conduct of video conferencing).

- 13. The Contractor shall provide sub watt-hour meter and water submeter for the purpose of monitoring the power consumption that will be charged to the Contractor.
- 14. The Contractor must submit NBI or Police or Barangay Clearance of its personnel to be assigned at the PICC.

- 17. The area for temporary facility with portable toilet for the contractor's personnel shall be provided by PICC. However, it shall be constructed, installed, operated, maintained, and subsequently removed by the Contractor.
- 18. As a special condition, of the Project/Contract as it is a Gender and Development (GAD) structured Project, the Contractor must assign a lady engineer/s or staff under the key personnel position/project workforce.

- 19. The Contractor shall ensure that its assigned personnel shall comply with, and submit to the rules and regulations of the PICC on security, sanitation, safety/health, other environmental compliance as well as on the use of gender-fair language while inside PICC premises.

- 21. The Contractor should free the PICC and its personnel from and against all liabilities arising from injuries or liabilities to persons or damages to property occasioned by any act or omissions by the Contractor including any and all expenses, legal or otherwise which may be incurred by PICC and its personnel in the defense of any claim, action or suit.
- 22. The Contractor shall undertake full responsibility and liability for any damage or loss of property or death of personnel, which may occur in the PICC premises arising from the fault or negligence of any of its personnel.
- 23. The Contractor shall provide bi-monthly regular check-ups and emergency service (check-up, trouble shooting and general minor repair) on on-call basis within 24 hours after receipt of call free of charge within the warranty period and shall provide a service report for the monthly check-ups and emergency services made.
- 24. Must be authorized distributor/dealer, installer and service contractor of elevators and escalators in the Philippines
- 25. Must have an After-sales Support System which is automated customer services in nature which provides 24 hours a day assistance and is available on line.
- 26. The Contractor shall assist PICC in the renewal (for the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th year of operation) of application for the Permit to Operate (PTO) of the elevator/escalator and other government permits and clearances one month before the expiration. The Contractor shall perform all the required elevator/escalator test/s and issue all required Certificate/s signed by their Professional Mechanical Engineer (PME) that are needed for the renewal of PTO and should be physically present along with the MSD personnel during annual inspection conducted by the Local Government Unit

(LGU)/Government Permit Issuing Agency (GPIA). Coverage of assistance shall be from filing of the necessary application form/s to the LGU/GPIA, assessment of the fee, and the corresponding payment.

27. The Contractor upon the request of the PICC or its authorized Technical/Mechanical services representative, shall provide stand-by service personnel free of charge for fast and immediate troubleshooting/restoration of **elevator** minor defect/s to ensure safe, proper and continuous operation of said equipment during big local and/or international events.

III. QUOTATIONS:

All quotations shall conform with the following conditions:

- a. Quotation/offer for the installation/fabrication work including all any other work/ charges shall be in Philippine Peso.
- b. Bid prices must be firm for at least one hundred twenty (120) calendar days after the date of bidding. Bidders' proposal must conform with all the stipulated specifications so with the sequence of the article(s) listed in the Proposal Form.

IV. WITHHOLDING TAX:

The PICC shall withhold and deduct the corresponding tax from the amount shown in the awardee's invoice subject to the provision of applicable laws and/or obligation.

Statement of Compliance

Bidders must state here either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered.

Note:

Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidder's statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the applicable laws and issuances.
