ADDENDUM NO. 01

This Addendum is issued to amend/revise certain provisions of the Bid Documents for the above-captioned procurement. Said amendments are as follows:

- Section III- Bid Data Sheet has been changed to read as:
 - ITB Clause 5.3
 - For this purpose, a similar contract shall refer to **supply** and installation of carpets.

The Bidder must have completed within the last five (5) years **one** (1) or two (2) contract/s that is/are similar to this requirement, the amount of which shall be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.

- Section V- Special Conditions have been changed to read as:
 - GCC Clause 5
 - Warranty
 - 10 years warranty on materials 1 year warranty on installation

A one (1) year warranty shall be provided for the installation workmanship of the Contractor. Additionally, a ten (10) year warranty shall cover all materials supplied by the Contractor. Said warranties shall include travel time, expense, and provision of on-site service and labor for any necessary corrections, repairs, or replacements arising from defects in installation or materials during the warranty periods.

The obligation for the one (1) year installation warranty shall be secured, at the Contractor's option, either by retention money equivalent to five percent (5%) of the Contract amount or by a bank guarantee certificate of the

same value. This warranty obligation shall be released only upon expiration of the one (1) year installation warranty period, after final acceptance. However, the retention or guarantee shall be forfeited in favor of the PICC if the Contractor fails or refuses to repair or replace, at no cost to the PICC, any damage to equipment, materials, or any PICC property at the worksite attributable to the Contractor during installation or the warranty period.
